Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Thursday, January 24, 2019, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Sandee Bryan Marion, Justice Rebeca C. Martinez, and Justice Irene Rios.

The following case will be presented:

Gloria R. Proo v. State – Gloria Proo, the step-grandmother of five-year old J.W., appeals her conviction for injury to a child by omission (failing to provide adequate nutrition or failing to obtain medical care), which caused serious bodily injury to J.W., and ultimately his death. On appeal, Proo raises multiple issues challenging the sufficiency of the evidence, including whether she "assumed care, custody, or control" of J.W. within the meaning of Penal Code section 22.04(d). Proo also challenges the trial court's rulings admitting and excluding certain evidence.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court's Courtroom, Cadena-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
