## ORDER DETERMINING PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

ON THIS DAY, the Court considered Defendant's Motion to Dismiss and Motion for Order Determining Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant and Requesting Security and Prefiling Order. Plaintiff appeared pro se. Defendant appeared by and through counsel. Upon consideration of the motions, the arguments of the parties and counsel, and the filings in this case, the Court finds that:

- 1. There is not a reasonable probability that Plaintiff will prevail in this litigation against Defendant, as Plaintiff's states no cause of action with a basis in law or in fact, and Defendant has raised the affirmative defenses of limitations and res judicata.
- 2. Plaintiff Thuy Sunosky has previously filed suit against Defendant which was finally determined against Plaintiff in Cause No. 2012-004596-3, Tarrant County Court at Law No. 3. Plaintiff unsuccessfully appealed that final determination in Cause No. 02-13-0032-CV.
- 3. Plaintiff subsequently filed suit against Defendant in Cause No. 2014-004069-2, Tarrant County Court at Law No. 2. After a trial to the Court, the Court finally determined that cause against Plaintiff. Plaintiff likewise unsuccessfully appealed that final determination in Cause No. 02-15-0030-CV. Plaintiff then sought review by the Texas Supreme Court, which was denied, in Cause No. 16-0406

- 4. Plaintiff subsequently filed suit against Defendant and others in Cause No. 017-323109-21, 17th Judicial District Court, Tarrant County. That cause was nonsuited and dismissed with prejudice.
- 5. After the above litigation has been finally determined against Plaintiff, she has repeatedly relitigated or attempted to relitigate, pro se, the cause of action, claim, controversy, or any of the issues of fact or law determined or concluded by the final determination against Defendant.

Based on these findings, it is ORDERED that Plaintiff is a "vexatious litigant" as set forth in Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code Chapter 11;

It is further ORDERED that Plaintiff is prohibited from filing any new litigation in any court in this state, without first obtaining permission of the appropriate local administrative judge, as provided by Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.102. Upon requesting any such permission, Plaintiff is ordered to provide a copy of the request to all Defendants named in the proposed litigation;

It is further ORDERED that the clerk of this court shall provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System within 30 days of its signing, pursuant to section 11.104(b);

It is further ORDERED that the Office of Court Administration shall identify Plaintiff as a vexatious litigant on its website pursuant to section 11.104(c); and,

It is further ORDERED that this cause be dismissed with prejudice pursuant to Tex. R. Civ. P. 91a. SO ORDERED  $\frac{10}{2000}$ , 2021
