Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral argument in one case on Thursday, November 17, 2022, beginning at 10:00 a.m., before a panel consisting of Chief Justice Rebeca C. Martinez, Justice Irene Rios, and Justice Liza A. Rodriguez

The following case will be presented:

Consolidated Towne East Holdings, LLC v. The City of Laredo, Robert A. Eads in His Official Capacity as City Manager, and Riazul I. Mia in His Official Capacity as Director of Utilities. The issues in this appeal concern whether appellees the City of Laredo and its officials acted lawfully by not selling appellant Consolidated Towne East Holdings, LLC “Living Unit Equivalencies,” which appellant asserts are necessary for the land development of its land, located in the City’s extraterritorial jurisdiction.
